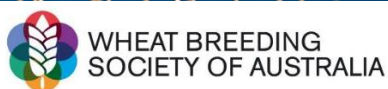

2019 Wheat Breeding Assembly Scholarship Opportunity

InterGrain will support a WA-based science student to attend the Wheat Breeding Assembly (WBA2019) on the 20-22 August 2019 at Adelaide Oval.

WBA2019 will showcase the science, practice and impact of variety development for Australia's wheat industry.

Australia's wheat industry (breeders, researchers, students, growers, agronomists, end users and policymakers) will come together to discuss:

- Future wheat variety traits required to meet the challenges of future environments, cropping systems, markets and products
- Innovations in plant breeding practices accelerating genetic gain
- New science and technology to boost progress in wheat breeding

InterGrain will provide \$1500 for the successful applicant which can be used for airfares, accommodation and conference registration

The Wheat Breeding Society encourages participation at #WBA2019. The successful applicant will need to present an oral or poster presentation. Topics of potential interest include (but are not limited to):

- Data management/analysis
- Abiotic stress traits
- Biotic stress traits

- Capacity development for wheat breeding
- The business of wheat breeding
